20/00929/FUL	Hardwood decking project at rear of garden on unused, unmanageable area of land on southern boundary. Beech Tree House 16 Sandy Lane Brewood STAFFORD ST19 9ET	The Parish Council objected to this retrospective planning application. The elevations were not to scale and were inaccurate. The decking was to the detriment of the street scene of St Chads Close, with nothing to encourage it. A semi-mature silver birch was taken down without permission. It interfered with neighbours' quiet enjoyment of their amenity area. The space was described as "unmanageable", however the neighbours with the same slope had managed to create a terrace with green plants, and if left to nature, the area would green over by itself.
21/00165/FUL	Single storey rear extension Brontside Poplars Farm Way Coven WOLVERHAMPTON WV9 5EQ	No comment
20/01166/FUL	Proposed dormer window to front of dwelling and single storey side extension 29 Shop Lane Brewood STAFFORD ST19 9EB	No objection, although this was no longer a bungalow and the Parish Council was concerned about the size of the upstairs on what was a bungalow in a conservation area.
